JOHN 9: HEALING OF THE MAN BORN BLIND

Three points to prepare us for the text:

- 1. This miracle is to be identified with Christ's "Light of the World" discourse in the previous chapter (compare 8:12; 9:5).
- 2. The blind man's physical cure precedes his spiritual cure: i. e., his coming to faith in Christ.
- 3. Ch. 9, as we shall see, illustrates human-viewpoint-theology that is 100% wrong!
